

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING HELD AT CITY OF SKY VALLEY, GEORGIA
ON APRIL 28, 2020, ON A TUESDAY AT 10:00 AM, VIA TELECONFERENCE (ZOOM)**

1. Call to Order

Mayor Steil called the meeting to order.

2. Invocation

Jan Mason led the Invocation.

3. Approval of Minutes

March 17, 2020 – Regular Council Meeting

Councilor Oliver made a motion to approve the minutes as presented, seconded by Councilor Turner, unanimously approved.

4. Adoption of Agenda

Mayor Steil wanted to amend the agenda so that two additional names could be added to the Marketing Committee Appointments, Jim Curtis and Harry Collins. Also, the removal of a name, Howard Beckert. Councilor Turner approved the amended agenda, seconded by Councilor Barrick, unanimously approved.

5. Mayor's Remarks

Mayor Steil read a statement submitted by Helen Kleiber, thanking the Sky Valley Police Department and Officer Brown for contacting her concerning something that was out of the ordinary, at her residency. Officer Brown had spotted it as he was patrolling the City. Helen stated that it was comforting knowing that they are patrolling at night, while they slept. Mayor Steil had also read a statement from Jim and Dottie Rhodes, thanking the Fire Department along with the Police Department for their quick response to their house that was struck by lightning. 6. Consider Approving of Additional Marketing Committee Appointments:

Councilor Barrick made a motion to accept these Committee Appointments, seconded by Councilor Turner, unanimously approved.

7. Consider Approving Road Striping 2020 and Awarding Bid to Daniel Wilson – Precision Striping, in the Amount of \$15,375.36

Councilor Morley made a motion to approve the road striping bid by Daniel Wilson of Precision Striping in the amount of \$15, 375.36, seconded by Councilor Curtis, unanimously approved.

OLD BUSINESS

8. Consider an Ordinance adopting and enacting a new code for the City of Sky Valley; providing for the repeal of certain ordinances not included therein; providing a penalty for the violation thereof; providing for the manner of amending such code; and providing when such code and the ordinance shall become effective

Councilor Curtis made a motion to adopt the Codification Ordinance, seconded by Councilor Morley, unanimously approved.

9. Public Forum and General Comments

Mayor Steil had read some questions that was sent to her before the meeting, which consisted of:

- Do you still have to shelter in place after self-quarantining for two weeks, when returning to Sky Valley?
- When will the prohibiting of short-term rentals be lifted?
- Can we play pickleball, tennis or basketball as they are an outdoor sport?

City Manager Fast read two questions that were written in Chat:

- Al Piontkowski asked why the City Manager was not provided, the review notes that Councilor Curtis had submitted to Mayor and Council, concerning the Codification Ordinance.
- Robert Smalley had questions concerning the pickleball courts.

There being no further business to come before Mayor and Council, Councilor Curtis made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Councilor Turner, unanimously approved.
