Commemorating the Life of Mr. David K. Whatley

Whereas: The City of Sky Valley, Georgia mourns the loss of David K. Whatley, a devoted Christian, husband, friend, professional and public servant;

Whereas: David K. Whatley was a Georgia native and, most recently, a resident of Sky Valley, Rabun County, Georgia. He was dedicated to his loving wife of 29 years, Kristin Danbury Whatley and a large extended family.

Whereas: David K. Whatley served as City Councilman of the City of Sky Valley from 2012 until his untimely death in 2014.

Whereas: David K. Whatley served a member of the Executive Committee of the Board of Directors for the Rabun County Tourism Development Authority.

Whereas: David K. Whatley graduated Magna Cum Laude from Mercer University with a Bachelor of Arts degree in economics and further graduated with a Juris Doctorate degree, Cum Laude from the University of Georgia Law School. He had a distinguished career as an attorney, instructor, corporate vice president, and consultant.

Whereas: David K. Whatley served in the Georgia Air National Guard and was a lifelong member of the United Methodist Church.

Whereas: David K. Whatley has demonstrated unwavering commitment to his service to the Sky Valley community; now
