

MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL CALLED COUNCIL MEETING THAT WAS HELD ON A TUESDAY AT 10:00 A.M. ON OCTOBER 26, 2021 VIA TELECONFERENCE (ZOOM) AT THE CITY OF SKY VALLEY, GEORGIA

1. Call to Order

Mayor Steil called the meeting to order at 10:30 due to the final public hearing regarding the 2022 proposed budget and setting of the 2021 millage rate, running over allotted time.

2. Adoption of Agenda

Councilor Allred made a motion for the approval of appointing Jerry Shope to the position of Public Works Director, seconded by Councilor Morley, unanimously approved.

4. Consider Resolution for the adoption of FY 2021 Millage Rate

Councilor Turner made a motion to approve the Resolution adopting the FY 2021 rate of 15.608, seconded by Councilor Allred, unanimously approved.

5. Consider Resolution for the adoption of FY 2022 Budget

Councilor Morley made a motion to approve the Resolution adopting the FY 2022 Budget, seconded by Councilor Turner, unanimously approved.
