### 4. Deliberation on Recommendation to Council for Short-Term Rental Ordinance

Dan McAfee asked if any changes were needed concerning the ordinance. Don Germano discussed the need for clarification under 41-04. "Renewal applicants shall file a renewal application accompanied by the required fee with the city clerk on or before the expiration date. If a short-term rental license expires due to non-renewal by the expiration date, a new application shall be required" to be added under this section. Don Germano made a motion to add the language under said section, seconded by Bill Oliver, unanimously approved.

Discussion concerning parking, vehicles and RVs, and whether or not any changes were needed. City Manager Streetman stated that the City Attorney felt that these issues are currently covered under other ordinances. Court Fees? Don Germano stated that the

judge would make that determination. Rental houses identification? Dan McAfee stated that the police would have the list of rental properties but it would not be advisable to single out rentals.

Dan McAfee pointed out some typos and duplications that need to be corrected in the ordinance.

With the approved changes, Don Germano made a motion to approve the ordinance and present to the City Council, seconded by David Spears, unanimously approved.
