Prior to the approval of Lisa banner, a committee of Jack Brandon, chair, Paul Evans, Gordon Brand, Sherron Van Camp was formed to recommend policies for real estate ads posted on our visitor website. The committee will present their recommendations at our next meeting on June 26th.

Forward Rabun Marketing Board Meeting Report – Sherron Van Camp (Placer.Al Company Program update)

Sherron was not able to attend May's meeting, but she is continuing to train with Placer AI and Forward Rabun to learn more about the program. At June's meeting, Rabun County will be named "Waterfall Capital of Georgia".

Rabun County Joint Comprehensive Plan Survey Update – Jason Streetman

The plan has been submitted since October of 2024. The county and the city of Tiger have yet to approve the final version. Adam Hazzel will keep Jason Streetman posted about the passing of the plan.

POA Survey, "Why People buy in Sky Valley" - Gordon Brand

The committee posed the question of how the survey could benefit the marketing committee. It was decided that the information is good to know where potential homeowners are from, the ages of our residents, and the importance of the natural and physical amenities of Sky Valley. Sherron will send the survey out via email to residents, and results will be discussed at a later meeting.

Time Shares of Sky Valley Update - Daniela Olvera

Daniela shared that the pool is now open. The workout area has a new fitness bike, a rowing machine, and 3 new treadmills. The floor in the work out area has been replaced, and the area has been painted. Several condo units are being updated with new paint, landscaping, and decking. The clay tennis courts are also being painted with fresh lines in the very near future. The months of June and July are booked with time share owners. The goal is to have several units ready to be viewed and used for short-term rentals by the end of July.

Stay and Play Golf Inquires and Stay and Play Accommodations - Ryan DeBois

Ryan stated that not much has changed regarding stay and play inquiries since most large groups have already booked for this summer season. Ryan did share that the Rabun County Sheriff's Office golf tournament has been booked for this October with over 100 local people playing at Sky Valley. Goody bags will be provided by the marketing committee.

Website Update – Sherron Van Camp

The website is updated regularly along with the Visit Sky Valley Facebook page. New events, pictures, and attractions are included in the updates.

Sky Valley Visitor Center Update – Jason Streetman

The visitor center is getting busier each day with the season change. Many people stop by for restrooms, directions, and purchasing Sky Valley merchandise. Directions to Mud Creek Falls is always a popular request among travelers.
